*** Please note: Current regulations in Malta state that in order to teach EFL (ELT) every teacher needs to be in possession of a Permit to Teach EFL. This is issued by the EFL Monitoring Board at the Department of Education. Subject to the following criteria:

- 1 Have successfully undergone a recognised TEFL Induction Course 60 hours (the GV Malta TEFL Course has been approved and recognised).
- 2 At least 18 years of age
- 3 Possess a Matriculation level of education (minimum).
- 4 Possess an A-level in English **or** a Pass in the TELT examination offered by the Department of Education from November 2004.
- 5 A current Police Good Conduct Certificate.

You do not need to possess these requirements in order to join the TEFL Course. Acceptance is at the discretion of the Director of Studies, who may ask to interview you in order to assess your level of spoken English. However, by the time you apply for a permit you will need to satisfy the other requirements.
